The Door (Jn. 10:1-10)

May you remember one word which is that Jesus Christ is your door. Jesus Christ is the door to every aspect of your life and those who live this life will live a victorious life. You will never perish and there is no question. Jesus Christ is your complete and perfect door. Of course at tines, you may question how must I live my life? You must be able to receive answers but how can you receive the answer? When you face continuous problems how can you receive continuous answers? At times, how can you live a meaningful life? Of course, you may face problems yet how can you live a meaningful life? In most cases many just live their lives but you must question yourself. Many people believe that if you make enough money and live a peaceful life that's a great life. However, many believers are stuck in this concept as well. It's very important to know the meaningful life that you must live. Of course, there may be various answers to it. However, in most cases the answer comes from the standard or level of others. Many people speak of the standard of the world like Genesis 3, 6, and 11. However, for you to live a victorious and meaningful life you must live by God's will. It's very simple but yet you always forget it. The reason why you must live by God's will is because God is the one who judges all things. It is God who has the power to bring the world to an end. That is why you must live by His will and His will is to save the 237 nations. His only will is to save the 237 nations and for all people to hear this gospel. He does discriminate against different skin colors or ethnicities. Of course, you must go and save all nations. It is not God's will to save only your nations. Of course, if there is a person who desires to save only their nation cannot. It's incorrect to have the mindset that you will first save your own people and nation and then the other nations. You must save all nations. This is God's ideology to save all nations. From the onset, this is God's will. God called Abraham and told him that he would bring forth and save all offsprings. Abraham had no choice but to leave his father's country and his kindred. Of course, God's will for Abraham was not to just remain in his own land and kindred but to go to the land that God planned for him to go. This is because God's plan for him was not to save only his people. The meaning of Abraham's name is that he is the forefather of a multitude of nations. The last words the Lord spoke to us was to go and make disciples of all nations. Also, to go and testify the gospel to the whole world. He said that you must stand as my witness till the very end. Your ideology must be aligned to His. You must never have your thoughts elsewhere, your thoughts must be aligned to His will. That is how you will receive answers and that is how your life will be revived. As you live your life being aligned to His will you will come to see that the life you lived was so valuable and meaningful. Of course you must have the mindset to save your nation but also other nations as well. If you only focus on saving

the people of your nation you haven't fully understood God's will 100%. You must be used to save the church and for the entirety of your life you must watch and protect the church. It is God's will for you to stake your life and save the church. However, if you are stuck within the boundary of the church you are not able to fully understand God's will. Of course, it's very important to run your business, work, and support your family but if you are only focused on this you have not completely understood his will. Your business must run for the sake of the 237 nations. Your occupation and the reason why you raise your children is for the sake of saving the 237 nations. May the remnants come to the conclusion that you study for the sake of saving the 237 nations. If you do this your life will take place. Your life, business, and economy will be revived. God will bless your economy because it is aligned to God's desire. Of course, it is the conclusion of the bible that if you align your business to God's will it is bound to take place. Matthew 6:33 says, "But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you". Of course, it's not that all your income must be given to tithe and offering. First and foremost you must be revived and you must save your family as well. The true meaning behind this scripture asks the reason why you run your business. God is questioning you, am I the center of your business and occupation. God is asking you, am I the center of your studies, life, and occupation. 237 does not exist only for God. This is the needed condition for you to have completeness within your life. You will not be at loss when you are aligned to save the 237 nations. That is the answer for you to live a complete and free life. That is why your spiritual eyes must be open to this. Your spiritual eyes must be opened so that you are matched with god. You must have the nature that through all things you do you must be for the sake of 237. May the blessing be upon you all so that you will see this. May you not be burdened but be aligned to save the 237 nations. Many of us may live our lives unconcerned of 237. Many may be burdened when the words 237 are spoken. However these are all incorrect. It is not a burden. It is God's blessing. God only desires for you to change your heart towards it. When you first change your heart to his will then the economy will be revived as well. This is a process. You are forcing yourself to give offering to God when you don't have the heart of 237. Please don't be burdened by my thoughts but if you are burdened regarding 237 please don't give offering to God. Even with the burden God will receive your offering. God does not desire for you to give him an offering that is a burden if you do not have a heart of 237. God is not a god with no money and God is able to do all things without any money. We desire to go and save souls. God can save countless souls without any money. May you have the economy where you can give to God with joy and thanksgiving because we need the economy for the sake of his will. I'm not trying to emphasize that you must be able to give offering, I am emphasizing that you must have the ideology of 237. With all the money that you give

for mission offering you will still have much left. How great would it be for you to have a strong conviction as well as your faith as you live with God?

1. The Door

For the sake of the word that he desires it is the door. This is the door where you will be able to receive the economy of light in all things so that you will be able to give all to God and be still with what you have remaining. In today's passage it says that he is the door to the sheep. In verse seven he says, "I am the door of the sheep." We are the sheep. In verse nine it says, "I am the door." Jesus is the door. Jesus is the door to all things in our lives. He's the door for you to receive salvation. There's no other door except for Jesus Christ to be saved. He is the door for your life and the door for you to receive answers. There are no other doors for you to receive answers. He is also the door to the future of your children. That is why you must be able to raise your children in this door of Jesus Christ. Here's the door to 237, healing, and mission. All that is taking place in this world is all done by the door of Jesus Christ. Even the sun rising and setting is all done in the door of Jesus Christ. If the work of preaching Jesus Christ to the ends of the world is finished there's no reason for the sun to exist. There will be a different light that will appear. In verse two it says, "But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep." In verse 1 it states, "He who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber." This is what Satan does. Satan is unable to enter God's door. It is because God will never permit that. That is why Satan has no choice but to be a thief and a robber. And he has no choice but to climb in another way. In verse 3 it says, " The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." That means that salvation can only be gained by the individual and Christ. Just because your father is a man of faith does not mean that the salvation will be inherited by the child. Just because the sun is a renowned pastor does not mean that the salvation will be given to his parents. Every individual must make the confession of faith that Jesus is their Christ. In verse 4, "When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice." This is so rightful. If Jesus goes before us we must follow after him. I'm verse 5, "They will not follow a stranger's voice." The stranger's voice is Satan. In verse 9, " I am the door. If anyone enters me he will go in and out and find pasture." Not only will you be saved but as you go in and out you will find pasture. You'll be able to receive the answer to prayer, the authority, and the blessing that will be given to you within all the physical aspects that you need as well. In verse 10, "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly." It is the same as verse 9. It says that through me because I am the door the sheep will be saved. They will have life and have it abundantly. It means that physically and spiritually

they will have life and have it abundantly. All the very victorious and successful figures of the Bible lived this life. The word that represents Abraham is the altar. The spiritual victory that God has given to him was to give the sacrificial offering and build an altar. That is how he became such a man of wealth. Also for Isaac and Jacob they were such prosperous men. For all the victorious biblical figures as well as the seven remnants they all lived successful lives. For Joseph, he became the governor of Egypt. That is why his life was abundant. For Daniel, he was able to reign as the governor even with four changes in reign for the kings of that age. Some even say that Apostle Paul suffered so much. And he did. May you think about the surrounding people. Think about the surrounding elders that could fully support the missions that he did and the spiritual blessings he had. If I lived in the same age as Apostle Paul, I would fully support him even if I had no money to give. And seen to the eyes, he had countless disciples. This Gospel movement was able to be passed on for the next 300 years. Not only that but imagine the spiritual blessings he received from God. You may have many concerns because 24 is not taking place for you. But if God pours His grace upon you, you will be in that place. Apostle Paul received that grace. I simply desire to be in the place of Apostle Paul. He lived an abundant life. You will only be abundant if you hold to Only Christ as your door. That is why you must hold onto Jesus Christ as your door. If you see anything else as your door, may you change your thoughts. There are many times when we hold onto things that are not Jesus Christ as our door. That is incorrect and that is not what God had promised. The doors to your economy will be opened through Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is the door to your life. The doors to your childrens' future will be opened only through Jesus Christ. If you do not have these thoughts, you must change them. This must become your imprint, root, and nature. You must firmly hold to the covenant to the point that Satan cannot attack you. That is why you must receive the Word and hold to the Word. There are countless words in the Bible that represent Christ. In Genesis 1, Christ is referred to as the light. God said "Let there be light," and there was light that signified Jesus Christ. In Genesis 2:2 it states, " And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done." God purposefully rested on the seventh day to signify the true rest that is in only Christ. God can never be tired, but he purposefully rested on that day. There are many examples like this. Genesis 3, the original curse occurred to which he was able to strongly emphasize the offspring of a woman that could crush Satan's head, which is Christ. And he spoke about the blood sacrifice that signified Christ. This continues into Genesis 4, where he says that "You must be able to bring the blood so that it becomes the promise between you and I." Noah's ark, Abraham's altar, and the precious blood that was posted on the doors in Exodus, all signify Christ. God tells them to build the ark of the covenant that signified Christ. ALl of the objects placed inside of the covenant

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signified Christ. Last week, we took a look at a representative object, the mercy seat. The Three Feasts represent Jesus Christ. The Bible is full of these evidences. It is Jesus Christ who has died on the cross, shed his blood, and completed this all. All you have to do is hold to the blood of the covenant, for that is the door to every aspect of your life. There are various explanations describing Jesus Christ, but behind all of that contains the power and authority of God. If you simply hold to one of them, you can experience God's power and authority in your life. Two Weeks ago, we saw the man who was born blind. He washed his face in the pool of Siloam and regained sight. How is this possible? He met Jesus Christ. This would be impossible if he met someone else. Others may try their best with their tears and effort, but yet it can never work out. For Jesus, it was so simple. He told him to go to Siloam and wash his eyes. Then everything was healed. Jesus is your door. How important is this? Countless words can explain Jesus Chirst, but He gave us the Word today, the door That is why you must receive Jesus Christ as your complete and eternal door. You must receive him to the point in which there is no other door but him. Because he is the complete door, you should not half-heartedly believe this. May the blessing be upon you so that it is only Jesus Christ. May you never be shaken or swayed and when you face problems may you challenge them with Christ. Of course, there are various problems. It's the same when you pray. However, we only have one prayer: that Jesus is my Christ. Regardless of all the problems you face, instead of asking God to solve this and that, you must pray, "God, let Jesus Christ be my only door to all." When you truly hold onto Jesus Christ as your door and as the covenant, the door will be opened. It is God's promise. If you hold onto Jesus Christ as your door, He will open the door for you. This is what it means to live the walk of faith. That is why, in the place that you are, may you hold onto Jesus Christ as your door and wait until He opens the door for you. This is what we call challenging: when you are able to hold onto His Word as the covenant and wait. This is what you must be able to do. This is a normal life. This is what we call a walk of faith. So, may you hold onto the door of Jesus Christ. Most people just believe in Him and put Him aside. But by God's grace, we are able to continuously hear that we must hold onto Him as the covenant. Yet, there are so many of us that take it lightly to which we don't hold onto Him as the covenant. So, may you truly hold to only Jesus Christ and stay still. And if it's not taking place for you, then may you pray to God: "God, why is this not working out for me?" To be honest you don't need any other prayer topic. And everything else will come to an end if only Jesus Christ is your door. He is the door to your life and the door to all your problems. That is why Jesus says today, "I am the door." What happens if you try to open a door that will not open? Everything will fall apart. Then, why do we do that? If you hold onto Jesus Christ as your covenant, you will never be in that state. I can't say that I am a complete witness to you all because I am

so lacking. But I can say I am a witness. What kind of witness am I? I am a witness to the fact that, if you hold onto the confession that Jesus is the Christ, the door will be opened. This is the path you must take because God said that Jesus is the Christ and the only answer. Of course, there are countless witnesses recorded in the Bible, in the church history, and also our church denomination. Although I am lacking, I believe I am one of those witnesses. There must be a door that opens every aspect of your life. You must be able to truly hold onto Jesus as your Christ, and when you hold onto Jesus Christ as your door, everything will be opened for you. That is the true door. And even if there are different methods to open up the doors, you must use Jesus Christ who is the only door. The Lord says today, "I am the door." Then, what must you do? You must receive Him as the door and confess, "You are the door, the door to my life, the door that will resolve all problems." You must be able to confess, "I believe You are the door to which You will open all the doors that have been closed in my life." You must live this life continuously. Of course, the door of Jesus Christ will continuously open every aspect of your life. This will take place. You're not sure because you haven't tried it. You simply heard of it and just let it pass by. If you do it, it will take place. That is why you must live a life that conquers. Not only that but you must live a free life given by God. First and foremost, you must conquer yourself because Genesis 3 is all about being "me"-centered. It's not centered on God or 237. Everything is centered on yourself. You must hold to that. But if you continue to hold onto your own center, you will be attacked by Satan. If you simply hold to yourself and have a small heart for offering, you will be deceived by Satan. Of course, if you give your all to God, you will not perish. Yet, you continue to hold onto yourself because you are self-centered. That is why you must conquer yourself and your life. You must have liberation from all the snares as well as enslavement. You must be healed and stand as a sure witness. Even for myself, I shouldn't do what I desire. But when I took a look back, I was able to see that many things took place because of God. Even though it doesn't take place how you want it to, a lot has taken place. Let's take a look at Verse 11. It says, "I am the good shepherd, the good shepherd that lays down his life for the sheep." That means He is a hired hand. Do you believe in Jesus Christ? He is a good shepherd. What does that mean? He doesn't lie. What else did He say? "I am the door to your life. There is no other door, for I am the only door. If you enter through this door, things will be done for you." He is not only the door for you to be saved. When you go in and out of the door of Jesus Christ, you will find pasture. You will receive life, and it will be abundant. That is why He is the door to your life. He is the door to all your problems. So, if you face a problem, enter the door of Jesus Christ. May the blessing be upon you so that this Word will be your covenant. May you be victorious in which, in all problems, you will enter the door of Jesus Christ.
