God made The Covenant (Ex. 34:10-28)

God made the covenant and it's very important. If God didn't make the covenant there would be no hope for mankind. They would have no choice but to continuously be defeated by satan. However, when you hold to the covenant not only will you overcome Satan but also the disasters that come to you. How thankful are we that God established the answer. May the blessing be upon you all so that you are able to enjoy this everlasting grace. As long as you hold to the covenant and confess you will be able to experience this taking place in your life. May you once again hold to this covenant. He said, if you hold onto what I have given to you I will cast out all nations. He says, not only will I cast out that nation but I will also enlarge your borders when you hold to my word. That is why it is the gospel, through the gospel you are able to gain all things for free. It is the covenant where if you hold to it and place it within your heart He will cast out your enemies and enlarge your border. It's truly outstanding. This is the word God proclaimed not only to Moses and the Islrealites but also to the people of all nations at that time. That is why the people in Moses' age didn't question God and went to the land of Canaan. This was not only the answer to the Isrealites but also to the people of all nations at that time. For all of the people of the nations, if they simply followed after the Isrealites they would be able to see the work of God take place. God has not only spoken the word to those who believe in Him but He proclaimed this word to the people of all nations. Even for the nonbelievers the standard of their judgement lies within the covenant as well. If the non believers come inside the covenant all will take place accordingly. In the age of Moses they needed to apply the blood of the lamb on their doorpost in order to enter into the land of Canaan. That is why the land of Canaan was the absolute answer for the people in that age. Not only that they will be able to see miracles and receive answers to pass through the wilderness in order to enter the land of Canaan if they did not question God. Whoever stays within the wilderness has no choice but to face their own death. However, if they hold to God's covenant and remain within the wilderness they would live for 40 years even 400 years. This is God's mystery that He reveals to His people by recording it in the bible. This is the mystery to your life, you must hold to the covenant and enter Canaan. Of course, you may pray to God so that He can answer your personal prayer topics however if you simply hold to the covenant and enter the land of canaan all things will take place. There are many times that we express our lives similar to the wilderness. However, there is the mystery that you must hold in order to pass through the wilderness. Regardless, for any other reason you must enter into the land of Canaan. Even with faith alone as long as you hold to the covenant you will be able to see answers and miracles arise as you pass through the wilderness. Regardless of any other reason or problem you face, as long as you hold to the covenant you will be able to enter into the land of Canaan if not you cannot enter. In the bible, it records the few number of people who hindered or objected to entering the land of Canaan. In the end, those people all perished and died within the wilderness because they couldn't enter into the

land of Canaan. Of course you cannot interpret it as if they all ended up in hell because they did not enter into the land of Canaan. Rightfully so, you must be able to enjoy the blessing that Joshua and Caleb enjoyed yet, the people at that time couldn't enjoy it. They just needed to simply enter into the land of Canaan. God's plan is unchanging that's why we call it the absolute plan. World evangelism, 237, and the 5000 people group are God's unchanging plan. The four resurrection messages will never change. The resurrection message is the present time land of Canaan. So if you head towards it you will be able to enter. That is why just like Joshua and Caleb that enjoyed the answer, you must be able to enjoy it as well. What's the point if remaining within the wilderness and perishing when you can simply enter into the land of Canaan and receive all the blessings God has prepared. We all know the story of what took place in Kadesh Barnea where all the Isrealites lamented before the Lord. The ten scouts who returned back gave the report and lamented all night long. The ten scouts who were the representatives of the ten tribes said words that proved to be right. That's why the Isrealites fell for it and the Isrealites fell into an uproar. We must not speak of the words that prove to be right but yet, we must speak of the words of faith. May you speak the word of faith and the covenantal word first. May you not speak such negative words to yourself for God is almighty. Even for others may you speak to them with positive words for God is almighty because you are a child of God and they are also a child of God. That's why you should speak of words that encourage them like let's do it or let's pray together. Yet, there were people that objected or hindered them from entering into the land of Canaan. You should not commit such foolish acts like they did. 237 is an unchanging answer from God that is why there is no need to use pessimistic words such as, let's not go or let's not do that for you must go. The covenant is clear. You must discern and judge all things according to this covenant. You will be able to receive answers and see the miracles take place just as it took place within the wilderness as well. Within the small decisions that you make in your life, may you align it to 237. You must be able to personally hold onto the covenant of Christ. Not only will you be blessed but your posterity will be blessed as well. When you take the path of the covenant journey, you will be able to see the covenantal answer. So, may you all hold to the covenant of 237. And may you place it inside of your heart and never shake.

1. Do Not Make a Covenant With the Inhabitant of the Land

The first point we'll look at is "Do Not Make a Covenant With the Inhabitants of the Land." In the first half of the scripture, it says you should not make an idol. In the latter half, it says that you must keep my covenant. It is the conclusion of today's Bible scripture that you must not follow after the idol worship of Satan yet keep my covenant. In Verse 10, it says, "Before all your people, I will do marvels." And it says that all the people will fear you. It's because God will do such tremendous work to which they will be in fear. In Verse 11, it says, "Observe what I command you this day." And then He says, if you do so, "I will drive out before you." When you keep God's commandment, it is God who will drive our enemies out. It is truly amazing. And there are neg-

ative effects to it whenever you try to fight against it with your own will. If you have an opponent and have to fight the opponent, may you hold onto the covenant. Satan is your opponent. That is why you shouldn't shout or scream but hold onto the covenant and fight against Satan. Verse 12 states, "Take care, lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land to which you go, lest it become a snare in your midst." Those people are the ones who serve Satan. That is why you must not associate yourself with them. In Verse 13, it says, "You shall tear down their altars and break their pillars and cut down their Asherim. Whatever idol that you see, you must break it down. In Verse 14, it says, "... for you shall worship no other god, for the Lord, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God." He says, "I am a god full of love. That is why you shall worship no other god." In Verse 15, it says, "... lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land, and when they whore after their gods and sacrifice to their gods and you are invited, you eat of his sacrifice." This is possible. However, you must be able to interpret that everything has first been given to the Israelite men. For at that time, it was male-centered. However, it was at the time in which the other nations would invite the men to come. So, the men would follow after them and enjoy their time and God feared that that would take place. In Verse 16, it says, "... you take their daughters for your sons, and their daughters whore after their gods and make your sons whore after their gods." Verse 17 says, "You shall not make for yourself any gods of cast metal." The Lord says do not make yourself any god and bow down to it. And the Lord says in the first half of the scripture that you shall not fall into idol worship. You shall not make yourself an idol or associate with those who fall into idol worship. Of course, in the present time, we live amongst the non-believers. However, it's not that we should not associate with them completely. Spiritually, we should not be influenced to fall into their idols in which they serve the demons. However, you should interpret that you must save them from the cure that they are seized by. In the past, God has already resolved to put everyone to death who did idol worship. It was the same for Noah's aige. In order to save Noah who held onto the covenant, he wiped out all of mankind who fell into idol worship. To that extent, those people fell into wickedness. At that age, in the perspective of God who is full of love, He saw that all His people fell into idol worship and were severely wicked, fallen into lust to which He had to wipe them out. The representative war of that time was the battle of Jericho in which God said to kill all mankind, including the livestock. God said He will make it all clean through this. That is why God says not to associate with those that fall into idol worship. Even now in the present time, it is the same. He says that you shall not associate yourself with those who serve the demons, for you shall keep the covenant. Of course in America, there is a lot of idol worship. You must not be like the past and carve out your own idol and bow down. And there are rumors that say that many people sacrifice humans to their gods. However, America is filled and deeply rooted with the idols of ideology and materialistic wealth. Of course, there are many idols that take place through politics, government, and even through the culture. We all know that the second movement of the Babel Tower is on the rise. That is why you must open your spiritual

eyes and discern yourself from those things. You must be aware and protect yourself with the covenant. That is why you must not worship any other idol. You must receive this word as your own personal message and meditate on it. Then, your idols will be revealed. May the grace be upon us in which we are able to cut off all idols that we have.

2. Keep My Covenant

The second point we'll look at is "Keep My Covenant." In Verse 18, it says that you must be able to keep the appointed time of the month of Abib which is the Feast of Unleavened Bread. The bread without yeast signifies the body of Christ that is sinless. And it has no taste. However, as you eat that bread, you must think of God. The reason why God tells them to commemorate it is so that they always remember that they have been liberated from Egypt. God says, "Do not forget the blood and the body of Christ Jesus by which you have been saved." God says that you must never forget that night of the precious blood of the lamb. That is why we must be able to commemorate that as well. You must continuously commemorate the precious blood of the lamb and of Jesus Christ so that, one day, it will truly become your own personal covenant. When that truly comes inside of you as your own personal covenant, there will be the spiritual effect that takes place. You gain spiritual power and strength and you will have pride within the covenant to which you will be able to acknowledge and confess to yourself, "It is alright because I am a person of the covenant." For us, in order for this to take place, we must continuously commemorate it. Without you even noticing, one day it will take place within you. When this takes place within you, you have come to the answer. In verse 19 it says, "All that open the womb are mine, all you male livestock, the firstborn of cow and sheep." In verse 20 it says, "The firstborn of a donkey you shall redeem with a lamb, or if you will not redeem it you shall break its neck." This means that the lamb will die on the behalf of the firstborn of the donkey and the donkey will live. Who wants to kill the firstborn of the donkey? Instead, they redeem it with the lamb. We must also consider, how come it is the firstborn of the donkey rather than any other animals? When Jesus entered the city of Jerusalem, he was on a donkey. That was predestined beforehand that is why God has discerned a donkey. It is because the Bible only exists to explain Christ. All the topics contained inside the Bible all go to connect and explain Jesus Christ. In verse 20 it also says, "All the firstborn of your sons you shall redeem. And none shall appear before me empty-handed." God says that if you desire for even your firstborn son to appear before me, you shall be redeemed with a lamb. It is the lamb that will die on behalf of the son. It says in verse 21, "Six days you shall work, but on the seventh day you shall rest. In plowing time and in harvest you shall rest." In the present time, we are talking about keeping the Lord's day. If you carefully take a look at it, there is not much of a difference. As you take a look at the past, you will be able to see that tremendous works have been taking place. With faith, you must observe and keep the Lord's day. There are many who simply come to church to observe the first service and leave to go to work. I'm thankful for the fact that our service does not end so quickly. There are many who desire to go to service at 7:30 or

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8:30 in the morning. Later on, they will be at a loss. They will be at a benefit when they keep the Lord's day. There may be many elements for your own happiness in life, but it is God who maintains all of that for you. There is no use for you to have so much money if your health is deteriorating. However, the Lord commands and says that no matter how busy you are you must keep the Lord's day. In verse 22 it says, "You shall observe the Feast of Weeks, the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the Feast of Ingathering at the year's end." This is the ceremony where you give your first crops to the Lord. God says that you must give your first crops to him. For it all belongs to God. It is God's message that how is it possible that we grow these crops, it would not be possible without God. It is the same for us who don't farm. It is normal of us to give our entire lives to God. However, God just takes the first crop. You must be able to give 1/10 of it to the Lord. We are truly thankful for the rest of it, God desires for us to use it. All that you have gathered throughout the season also belongs to you. That is how we commemorate the Feast of Ingathering. In verse 23 it says, "Three times in the year shall all you males appear before the Lord God, the God of Israel." All the males must worship before the Lord as they keep the Passover, the day of the Pentecost, and the Feast of Ingathering. The Lord says that "no one shall covet your land, when you go up to appear before the Lord your God three times in the year." The Lord tells the people not to worry in order to give worship to him. The Lord says that no animals, no people, not even Satan shall covet your land. The Lord says that you must be able to have faith in it and make the confession of faith. In verse 25 it says, "You shall not offer the blood of my sacrifice with anything leavened.." The leavened bread is the bread of the world which is full of yeast. However, all sacrifices given to the Lord must be given with unleavened bread. It also says, "or let the sacrifice of the Feast of the Passover remain until the morning." This is not the food that you will eat, this is the food that you have given to me. The Lord says, "Of course I have given you this food to eat, but this is the food I have given to you as the confession of faith." The Lord said that you must never mistake the sacrifice as food for you to eat. In verse 26 it says, "You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk." There are many interpretations regarding this sentence, but many people believe that those who serve the idols did this, so the Lord commanded his people not to do the same. It is very cruel to boil a young goat in its mothers milk. That is why the Lord commands his people not to do the same. In verse 27, the Lord tells Moses, "Write these words, for in accordance with these words I have made a covenant with you and with Israel." The Lord says that you must keep and protect it so that the posterity will be able to see it. The Lord says to take a look at it many times and place it in your heart and live according to it. This is why God told Moses to write these words. The Lord said, if you do so, I will enlarge your borders. He also said that all the enemies coming in to invade his land, he will cast them out. He also said that no one shall covet your land. This is God's promise. It is the same even now. You must keep the covenant. Today's Bible scripture is full of details. We already understand and know all of this because it connects to Jesus Christ. Inside of Christ contains many things. As much as you can see and hold to this,

you will be able to see it. As much as you are able to understand and hold to this, you will be able to see as well. As much as you enjoy Christ, you will be able to see all the things in Christ. It is God who has made the covenant. And we are truly thankful for that. If the covenant did not exist, we would all wander. And we would be lost with no answer. We would simply die without an answer. However, God has given the answer and that is the covenant. If you hold to it and struggle, trying to remain inside of it, you will be able to see yourself that all by the covenant alone, everything will be done. And when you hold onto the covenant and fight against the darkness, then the darkness has no choice but to crumble. When you pray holding onto the covenant, "God please revive my life," God will revive it for you. How thankful are you for this? God made the covenant and has given us the covenant. God says to write these covenants and to never forget the covenant. Keep and protect the covenant. Take a look at it and renew yourself with the covenant. Hold to it as your covenant once again and act on the covenant. Then, work will take place. This is the covenant. The Lord himself has given it to us. We never asked for it. Moses never asked for it as well. In the latter half, the Lord calls Moses. It was not Moses who appeared before the Lord, but it was the Lord who appeared before Moses. Moses did not write on the stone tablets of the Ten Commandments, but it was God. God says that it is His covenant. "This is my promise so if you follow it, it will be fulfilled. Then answers will be given to you." This is the path you must take but you continue to take the incorrect path and continuously ask other things before God. THe covenant must be your priority, but it is not. Because you have something instead of Christ, it becomes a religious lifestyle. Hold to God's Word as the covenant. This must take place within you. THis is your start. Just because you fervently pray before God does not mean it is a start. You must come inside the covenant first. That is the true start. May you hold onto Christ and go into the depths of 24 hour or in the depths of prayer. The Lord has given it to us. Isaiah 7:14 states, " Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel." This was prophesied 700 years before. The king was in an uproar because the two powerful nations from the northern side invaded them. God commands Prophet Isaish to speak to the kings and states that whether in the depths nor heights, you must seek God's Word. This means that ask God whatever it is that you need, and you will receive. The king said no, but God himself gave the sign. We must be truly thankful for the things the Lord has done. If we were in God's point of view, you would have felt offended and would have hurt pride, but God himself gave the sign regardless of this. Even if the strong powerful northern nations came to attack them, they were defeated. The word that prophet Isaish spoke was not about the way. It was the prophecy of what was to be fulfilled 700 years afterwards, but at that moment, works arose. He merely spoke of the prophecy of Christ who is to come, but works arose. That is why the Word that is proclaimed in the Old Testament is proclaimed even now. Even the words that were proclaimed 2,000 years ago are still being fulfilled even now. God has no concept of time. He has no concept of the time of His Word that would take place in the moment. God's Word, which is the covenant, always liberates man from all curses. It protects us from the work of Satan. Even now, it is able to bind the work of Satan. For God himself, there is no concept of time. It will take place even now. Regardless of the time of when the Bible was written, it does not matter because God is at work even now. That is how God gives us spiritual power so that we can stand as the witnesses to the end of the world. How thankful are we that we have been given this blessing? No matter how many times you say it, if there are no works that arise, you have no choice but to be frustrated. But if you simply confess the Word, works are bound to take place. This is God's promise, the precious blood of Jesu Christ on the cross. Works are bound to take pl;ace if you do not serve Satan and align yourself to 237. You have complete victory as long as you align yourself to 237 because this is your life answer. Before thi can become your commission, this is your life answer. You must hold to it and really live for 237. Admistall of the problems that you face, as long as you align to 237, you will see the answers. For the Israelites, in the wilderness, they were fed by God. Likewise, God will give us answers in our wilderness. There may be problems that are similar to those in the wilderness, where they were under the pillar of the cloud and fire. Regardless of that all, you will see miracles take place. TOu will be able to continue to live a life full of answers. 237 is the answer for mankind of this age, this including nonbelievers for this is God's mystery. God has revealed it only to His people which iis why it is a mystery. The nonbelievers do not know this truth, so they are seized and compelled by curses. We must have faith and believe that the four resurrection messages will be fulfilled. The disciples will be raised. I do have faith and strong conviction that many Multi-ethnic disciples and Remnants will be raised. I pray holding onto the covenant that many of our church officers and business people will be raised as disciples. I pray holding onto the faith that many of us will be raised as the ministers that will lead the regional church and team ministry evangelism. I was able to see that there are a few people on the list that need to be healed. I believe that God has given us the covenant of healing, so healing is bound to happen for those people. When I pray, I pray firmly holding ot eh vcovnanet, because God has made a promise. I believe that the Remnant movement will arise. It is God's desire, but He has promised us. I truly have faith as I hold to the covenant that we will be used to save 237 and South America. This is the answer to your life. This is not your commission. Commission comes after this. This is your life. This is your answer to your life and I pray that you will be a part of those who live for 237. It does not matter if you are within the wilderness because you will receive the answers and see miracles, surpassing the wilderness. May the grace be upon you all so that you may change your imprint, root, and nature.
