11/13/22 The Work of the Unprecedented and Never Repeated Answer

Sunday Service

Joshua 10:1-14

God has given you the promise and does according to it. Therefore, you must hold to the promise. Even if you know that the origin of all problems is the fundamental problem, it is a problem that you can never solve on your own. God has given a promise and Jesus Christ is the promise. Even today, God does according to the covenant and all events that arise in the world are centered on the covenant. If so, the direction you must take is so clear. Also, the Bible records many figures' life story who lived in how God has blessed them and the miraculous answer they have received. God has promised three things in Jesus Christ. First promise is to liberate mankind from sin and curses. Second promise is to crush the serpent's head and have complete conquest and victory over Satan in the spiritual battle. Last promise is that Jesus Christ has completed the way for you to meet and enjoy God for 24 hours as you gain eternal citizenship in heaven. You live your life on this promise. When you testify to the promise, God will be at work to save many. You must hold to the covenant as you give worship. All of God's blessing and promise will be fulfilled upon your fields.

1. The Work of the Unprecedented and Never Repeated Answer

- Today's bible passage records the work of the unprecedented and never repeated answer. The
 five kings of the Amorites gathered their armies against Gibeon. It records the event that
 occurred when Joshua and the Israelites were at war against them.
- 2) Verse 8 states, "And the Lord said to Joshua, "Do not fear them, for I have given them into your hands. Not a man of them shall stand before you." Verse 11 states, "the Lord threw down large stones from heaven on them as far as Azekah, and they died. There were more who died because of the hailstones than the sons of Israel killed with the sword." And Verse 13 states, "And the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, until the nation took vengeance on their enemies," just as Joshua prayed.
- 3) This is the summary of today's bible passage, but you must focus on the fact that God stopped the sun and moon. Although there is scientific evidence to prove this and is a historical event, it was a promise made by God.
- 4) Therefore, you must know the reason why God allowed this unprecedented work to occur in which you never imagined. Then, you will be able to enjoy the promise. God is at war for world evangelism. All of the idol worship was destroyed in the land of Canaan so that He can prepare the land for Christ's coming. So that in the land, God is preparing to take His people out of the three fundamental problems.
- 5) God has made you a promise through this tremendous process. "You must do world evangelism, and I will stop the sun and moon in your life. I will do the unprecedented and never repeated work that no one will ever imagine. Give your life to do the work that will save this world. Then I will be with you during the night." Just as the sun and moon stood still, the world is dying because of the curses of Satan.
- 6) If you live for world evangelism, then God will stop the sun until all of the problems in your life are solved. And He will make your life a life that can do more than kill your enemies with heavy stones. Like up for world evangelism. Do as Joshua did. God will stand forth and throw down heavy stones. Then it will be a life that God does.
- 7) God wants to tell you this today. May you hold this as your promise. God will stop the sun upon your life. He will throw down heavy stones to destroy your enemies. And may you live for world evangelism. You must give your life for the wars of Canaan. You must go all-in to give your life in the battle of Christ.
- 8) You must not care for the environment or people around you. It is a waste of time and a harm to you. You will be damaged spiritually. The situation does not matter. God said that it is Nothing and Nobody. You must conquer the environment and people while holding to the covenant. You are the one who holds the covenant. Congregation and Remnants, may this be your covenant once again.

2. Commission and Devotion

- 1) God has given you the answer, has told you to live, win, be victorious by it, and be a witness. It is the only desire God has. Of course, you who have been saved from this curse must live like this.
- 2) You may be in a difficult situation. Just do as much as you can. If you can only pray, that is sufficient. A deep, earnest, genuine prayer becomes the greatest devotion. You live in the wilderness. While there are always difficulties, there are always miracles. This is a characteristic of those who hold the covenant.
- 3) For those of you facing difficulties, may you receive strength and hold on to the answer God has given you, and start your life again with that answer. That is why the altar you build before God with your heart is very important. God has decided to solve it all through this.
- 4) In today's scripture, Joshua is a man who saw everything that happened to Moses. He saw the blood of the covenant on the evening of the Passover and all the works that God had done in Egypt. It must have been a day of great imprint. It was the same for the journey inside the wilderness.
- 5) Isaac is a man who experienced being a living sacrifice when he was young. His life simply ended with one chapter in the Bible. This is because the answer became very certain through the covenant. He conquered his land even after being chased. He also conquered the waters of his land.
- 6) It is important to devote yourselves to evangelism and missions even when you are lacking. What you do during difficult times will shine brighter for God. Please pray to raise disciples who will continue this Gospel movement in Venezuela.
- 7) If you align your life with world evangelization, God will stop the sun and the moon. He promised to do so until the end of your wars. God will give you blessings and give you the covenant to win.
