The Peak of Field Evangelism

Acts 19:1-41

Evangelism is the entire content of the Gospel that is recorded in the Bible. Also, the disciples are very important. Paul testified the Gospel each day to the disciples in the regions. Amazing work of evangelism arose as the disciples continued to hear the Gospel through Paul who came to visit them each time to which everyone in Asia heard the Gospel. This is the model of evangelism.

1. He set aside the disciples

- 1) 8 : He entered the synagogue and for three months
- 2) 9 : He took the disciples with him
- 3) 10 : For two years - All the Jews and Greeks in Asia.
- 4) If you know the importance of disciples, then you will come to know evangelism.

2. The miracles that rightfully follow

- 1) 11 : God was doing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul
 - (1) 12 : Paul's handkerchiefs, aprons - Their diseases left and evil spirits came out of them.
- 2) 13 : Undertook to invoke the name of the Lord
- 3) 14 : Sceva and seven sons
- 4) 17 : All the Jews and Greeks of Ephesus came to know of it.
- 5) 19 : Those who had practiced magic arts- Took, fifty thousand pieces of silver
- 6) 20 : The Word of the Lord continued to increase and prevail mightly.

3. Next ministry

- 1) 21 : I must go see Rome
- 2) 22 : Timothy and Erastus were sent to Macedonia.
- 3) He stayed a couple more days in Asia.
- 4) Paul's heart for the reason he sent Timothy and Erastus to Macedonia.

4. The rightful work of Satan that arose

- 1) 23 : No little disturbance of the Way.
- 2) 28-34 : For 2 hours, they spoke about how Great Artemis was in Ephesians.
- 3) 40 : No cause to justify the commotion.

5. Conclusion

- 1) God works through the prepared disciples.
 - (1) Matthew 13:1-9 Cannot bear fruit without being on the good soil.
 - (2) The good soil is God's prepared disciples.
- 2) You must possess the spiritual eyes to know the importance of the disciples to know God's evangelism.
