The One Who Connects with God's Will

1 Samuel 1:9-18

God does all things according to the word. God first gives the Word and then fulfills it. Therefore, you must receive the Word. It is important to receive grace and restore your spiritual state through worship. However, the core is to receive the word that God prepared for you today. Therefore, giving worship and prayer is important for your life. Your life does not take place according to your will but it takes place according to the Word. There is common grace and this is the grace given to unbelievers. Common grace means that one is able to live their life as it is. However, this is not the goal of your life. You must live a life of God's covenant in which the word is fulfilled. Therefore, you must live a life that God desires to which you will conquer yourself and the world and testify of this Gospel. Whoever lives their life following after the Word will have conquest. You can also liberate others from curses as well. The 3 works, which are promised inside of Christ, contain the authority of God that can transcend and conquer all things. Christ is the fundamental and the word received today is more specific. If this takes place you have the spiritual weapon in both hands. Life is simple. If you receive the Word during worship, confess and enjoy that Word during prayer, and continue to hold to the Word as your covenant then all of your problems will be resolved. You will continuously receive answers to prayers. At times, miracles that overturn problems will arise. May you receive the word once again today.

1. The one who connects with God's will

- 1) Today's bible passage is about Hannah, the mother of Samuel. It is recorded in Verses 1-8 that Hannah was loved by her husband, but God had closed her womb. But one day, she began to pray because of the resentment and anger she had. Through this, she was able to connect with God's heart and will.
- 2) Hannah thought of God's desire as she was praying and this became her life answer. This was God's Word and meaning in which it became Hannah's covenant. Surely, assurance followed and it states that from then on, "her face was no longer sad." (18)
- 3) The Word that God gave to Hannah became her life covenant and her prayers continued even when Samuel was being used as His servant. In 1 Samuel 2:21, it states that she conceived three more sons and two daughters.
- 4) This was not a simple life conquest that Hannah received. She was able to conquer her life alongside with all of her other problems. And as time passed, surely, Peninnah must have knelt before Hannah and Hannah must have saved her.
- 5) Samuel's words never fell to the ground, and his existence protected his nation as in 1 Samuel 7:14, it states that Israel was restored and delivered their territory from the hand of the Philistines. This is the message that the covenant frees you from your past as you must surely restore it.
- 6) This is the life conquest of one who connects with God's will, as it is the authority of His Word, and world evangelization. The one Word that God gave to Hannah did this work. You are also a historical person inside of God's plan just like Hannah. Therefore, you must also receive His Word.
- 7) Hannah was centered on restoring the Gospel during an age when the Gospel was despised. You must also be like this. God gave everything that Hannah needed. This is because restoring the Gospel is God's fundamental will.
- 8) God cherishes the Gospel the most. Everything is resolved inside of the Gospel and He gives all things to those that are inside of it. And He does all things for the Gospel. He does not do anything else if it is not for the Gospel. Is there anything else He must explain if the sun rises for the sake of Christ?
- 9) Therefore, you must always emphasize Christ and recognize that it is fundamental. You will receive His Word through this Gospel covenant. You must pray and give worship for this. May you receive this grace.

2. The prayer that holds to the covenant

- 1) The scheduled prayer that is centered on God's covenant saves the world. It will rightfully save not only your life, but the environment will be conquered as well. - 2) By God's grace, Hannah was a person of God's covenant. In that age, she came to realize what God desired and she received the historical blessing that connected with God's will.
- 3) Hannah's spiritual eyes opened to God's will. Rightfully so, the Word became Hannah's covenant and the center of her prayer. That became the reason for Hannah to pray and reason to live.
- 4) Until the day that Hannah was called by God, she continued to pray holding to the covenant and enjoyed true happiness in the time of prayer. With God's word that was the covenant to her to conceive a Nazarite son was her lifelong prayer. Through that prayer, it saved one nation, one age, and miracles continued on.
- 5) In that age, many people looked down on God's blood sacrifice to which two evil priests led such wicked acts to arise. They did not have the upright attitude to hold to God's accurate covenant.
- 6) In God's perspective, it was the most fundamental problem and needed to be resolved first compared to any problems in the world. However, there was one woman that knew the fundamental problem. It is truly a touching story.
- 7) It is the same even now. In this age, the Gospel is disappearing, the churches are changing because they do not testify the Gospel and preach about the things of the world or the words of others.
- 8) However, God has called you in this age. God has called you in this age as the Nazarite to save the world with the Gospel and for you to be the person that prays for the Nazarite to be raised.
- 9) God desires for you to be that person. Hannah did not sacrifice her life for nothing. God's abundant blessing was upon her life. It was all the same for the 7 remnants in the Bible. Through that, they were raised as the witnesses in the fields.
- 10) Then, how can you receive the same life answer as Hannah? This is a very important question. First, you must have faith. You must believe and receive Jesus Christ. Next, you must have God's desire as your covenant. In the midst of hardships, Hannah prayed and received answers.
- 11) God's blessing is always hidden in hardships. Do not blame or resent hardships, but you must pray. If God's desire is your covenant, then it will become your lifelong prayer without any efforts of your own. Your life will be done according to the Word.
- 12) Your life will be filled with God's blessing and you will conquer everything in life. You will stand as a witness to liberate others as well. This is the life of those who hold to the covenant.
- 13) May your life be just like Hannah's. If you continue the life of praying, receiving and following the Word, then God's time will come to you one day. Then, your spiritual eyes will open to see God's will for the age. That is when you will truly be a person of God. May that blessed day come to you.
