## **Beautiful Feet**

Sunday service

Romans 10:1-15

Last week's message was about Elijah's efforts and prayer, God had already given His Word and fulfilled it. Elijah followed after the covenantal Word, restoring the covenant. Elijah also killed all of Satan's prophets, restoring Israel's spiritual state. He then prayed and just as God had promised, rain fell. Prayer is very important (Luke 9:29). However, since the promise of the Word has already been given, what is left for you to do now is to pray. A few weeks ago a person of God from Judah was deceived by an old prophet from Bethel, which led to his death which was so heartbreaking. The message of this story was that there are no excuses when keeping God's Word. It was a message from God for that age where the Word was so dead to which they were heading towards the complete opposite direction of God's Word. This was the same for Elijah's age. So, the Word was given first, and in the process of the Word being fulfilled, the Gospel was restored, Satan was defeated, and it became an answer. May this principle of God become your covenant.

## 1. Beautiful feet

- 1) Today's bible passage begins with an earnest request from Apostle Paul about Israel wanting to receive salvation. Verse 2 states, "For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge." When it speaks of "knowledge," it means that they did not know that Jesus is the Christ. Therefore, their knowledge about the Bible was also incorrect. This is because when you do not know Christ, you can never understand the Bible. You must interpret the laws while being centered on the blood of this covenant.
- 2) Therefore, Verse 3 states, "For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness." The phrase "God's righteousness" is very broad. However, it is assured that there is a promise inside of the sacrificial offering.
- 3) Verse 4 states, "For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes." The end of the law for righteousness is what is recorded in Verse 3, of God's righteousness. Then, you will surely live.
- 4) If you summarize Verse 6-7, it shows you the end of righteousness of faith. It may be slightly difficult to understand, but those who gain suspicion about who will receive salvation is a disbelief of bringing Christ from the cross. It is God's will for Christ to die on the cross for then His will can be fulfilled, salvation can be given. Anyone who would bring Christ from the cross is going against God.
- 5) Verse 7 states, "or 'Who will descend into the abyss?" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead.)" This is also a disbelief. This is an action of blocking and disrupting the ministry of the cross of Christ.
- 6) Therefore, you must not gain suspicion and must believe that there is Heaven and Hell. You must believe in the death of Christ. There will be salvation in this. This is the end of the righteousness of faith.
- 7) Verse 9 states that when you believe, you will receive salvation and Verse 10 states, "For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved." It is simply a poetic expression, but explains the same thing.
- 8) If you have the righteousness of faith, then your salvation is complete so you do not have to go through the process of reciting it with your own mouth. Confessing it with your mouth is not a requirement of salvation. With faith, the requirements of salvation are finished.
- 9) Verse 13 states, "For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- 10) It concludes that those who begin with the correct knowledge, and keep God's righteousness, explain the gospel of the cross of Christ, and speak of faith will receive salvation. After explaining the gospel and faith, all that is left is evangelism.
- 11) Verses 14-15 states, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" This word is also recorded in Isaiah 52:7 which states, "How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who publishes peace, who brings good news of happiness, who publishes salvation, who says to Zion, "Your God reigns."
- 12) It states "How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news," in awe. You must live this life. You must relay this across many mountains and oceans. You must relay the message that you must fear salvation, relay peace, and that God rules over all mankind. May you receive this blessing.

## Christ

1) Jesus Christ is the answer. He is the key. Evangelism is to testify the answer and the key of Jesus Christ to save many. If you simply testify Jesus Christ, God will be at work to fulfill His will.

- 2) The answer to your life is to enjoy the answer of Jesus Christ. You must repeatedly hold to the covenant and confess in prayer. God's only answer is Jesus Christ and His answer is perfect. There is nothing else that is needed and His answer never lacks.
- 3) There are many reasons why you give worship to God. You must rightfully stand before God through worship. Children of God must give worship to God. Through worship, God will pour many blessings to you.
- 4) The representative blessing is the answer. You can only come to know that Jesus Christ is your answer through worship and prayer. God desires for you to discover this. Your spiritual eyes must be opened to this. If you realize it, it will come to your heart. When His time schedule comes, it will be imprinted in you. As time passes, it will be your covenant deep in your heart and you will make a deep confession.
- 5) God's spiritual work will be at work because the covenant is living and active and it is done according to the Word. Satan who works behind sin will be cast away, answers will appear, restoration will be upon you to which God's kingdom will be upon you.
- 6) The Bible states this from the first day the world was created. There were times of incidents and events that took place, but that was not the end, it was merely a process.
- 7) It is the same regarding the original sin. They thought that it was the end, but it was not. It was merely a process for the accurate covenant to be fulfilled. Therefore, there is nothing to be concerned about. However, there is something you must place in your heart.
- 8) You must place the covenant in your heart and live according to it. If you live by something else other than the covenant, then it will be difficult and troublesome. You will see unimaginable work arise in you if you live by the covenant. That is your answer and if continuation takes place, you will conquer everything.
- 9) Anyone who is in Christ is raised upon the Rock as the church of God. The gates of hell can never prevail against you. All the doors to your life will open because God has given you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Lastly, the gates of heaven will open when you use the key that God has given to you. Jesus Christ is the key. God has given you the key of Jesus Christ.
- 10) All the closed doors will open when you live holding to the key of Jesus Christ. It seems as if the doors are closed, but as time passes, you will come to see it was an important process. There are many examples like this written in the Bible. Joseph is a great example as well.
- 11) If you jump to conclusions based on what takes place, you will get hurt. God is alive even now and Jesus is the Christ. All you must do is to place the blood of Jesus Christ upon your life. This is what it means to live by the covenant.
- 12) The covenantal blood sets you free from curse. On that day, the head of the Serpent (Satan) was crushed. After that day, God was with them again after 24 hours. God was with the Israelites in the wilderness for forty years. They received quail and manna from above and water from the rock. Two million to three million people along with their livestock ate and drank in the wilderness. There was no one who starved and thirsty to death. Also, their feet did not swell.
- 13) Everyday the pillar of cloud and fire was upon them. You can live in this way as well. To summarize this life in one word is: conquest. Regardless of what problems that arise, it does not matter. God is with you and if God calls you, you must go.
- 14) May this be your covenant once again. You have received the historical Gospel of this age. It is His plan before creation and you have been called by God in the womb. For the sake of this historical work, may your spiritual eyes open, enlarge your heart, and look to God's work that will take place in the far future. If not, you will be greatly deceived by yourself.
- 15) May your spiritual eyes open to come to the conclusion of world evangelism. May it not be lip service to God. May you truly come to the conclusion and answer of world evangelism. Then, you will live a grand life. You will go into the depths of prayer and your heart and mind will change as well. That is how you will be able to refresh God's heart.
- 16) Why would you live your life using schemes and methods? May you look to God's work, live a grand life filled with happiness and conquest. May you truly be the conqueror that conquers your life, health, economy, evangelism, and mission fields.
