## **Disciples**

Romans 16:1-5

The blood of Jesus Christ solves the curses and fate of mankind. That is why the precious blood of Jesus Christ is the Gospel. The next most important thing is the mystery of enjoying the Gospel through prayer. Through prayer you will see the evidence of conquering your curses and fate. Your hope for prayer must be 24hrs. The content is Jesus Christ, and it is explained through words like the bartizan, journey, and guideposts. 24hrs is the volume of prayer and words such as bartizan, journey, and guidepost are the content of prayer. However, there are the fundamentals that you must do to achieve the prayer that everyone desires. That is enjoying Jesus Christ. Therefore, everything the Lord speaks about prayer is absolutely related to you. Of course, the Lord's Prayer, where the Lord tells you how to pray is absolute, as well as Matthew 6:33, which you know well. John 15:7 talks about an important prayer, and the same applies here. Therefore, the fundament of reaching 24hr prayer begins with the enjoyment of Jesus Christ. It's not what you say, the Lord has already said it all beforehand. Even today you must take this path and conclude all things within this.

## 1. Disciples

- 1. Romans 16 records the names of 36 disciples. There were evangelism disciples and church officer businesspeople disciples as well. Despite their different directions and commission, they were all called for and lived for world evangelism.
- 2. No matter what form you are in, you must live as a disciple before God. A disciple is an important person in the kingdom of God. God will do His work through that disciple.
- 3. And the disciple will be centered on the Gospel movement wherever they may go. With this, God has given you a tremendous message recorded in Matthew 13:8-9. It states, "Other seeds fell on good soil and produced grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. He who has ears, let him hear."
- 4. Become the one who sees with spiritual eyes open. You must become one that hears the principles of this disciple. There were many disciples near Apostle Paul. It was also written in today's Bible passage. There was Phoebe, who was a patron for many and fellow workers such as Prisca and Aquila. They were the greatest church officers, commissioners, and businesspeople.
- 5. They were businesspeople, church officers, and evangelism disciples so they had a place of worship in which they gathered all those around them. Verse 5 records, "Greet also the church in their house." Verse 14 records, "Greet the brothers who are with them." Verse 15 records, "Greet all the saints who are with them."
- 6. It also records all the families who are within this Gospel. Verse 10 records, "Greet those who belong to the family of Aristobulus." Verse 11 records, "Greet those in the Lord who belong to the family of Narcissus."
- 7. It is also recorded in 1 Corinthians 16 and Colossians 4. These people were centered on world evangelism even during the time of persecution as they rightfully received many answers and rewards.
- 8. You must also live this life. You have received the historical Gospel. The Gospel has never explained this accurately. If it was not during the time of Moody or Wesley, then there is no need to look back anymore.
- 9. May you become the disciple that stands at the center of this age. Then, may all your thoughts and movements be inside of God's greatest interest. You will then be seen as the most important person in the eyes of God.

## 2. Systematic evangelism

1. The system of evangelism must arise for the evangelists. Then, evangelism can be conquered. Apostle Paul did not see Jesus Christ, but he had the accurate Gospel compared to the disciples who were with Jesus Christ during his public ministry. The depths of the content and enjoyment was stated through the epistles he wrote and through many epistles written from different disciples.

- 2. There was a difference between the results and evangelism that Apostle Paul received compared to other Apostles. Apostle Paul's evangelism was centered on the accurate Gospel and disciples to the extent that the system continuously arose. As a result, Rome surrendered to Christianity.
- Everything was the work of God. Apostle Paul continuously acknowledged this through his
  confession and content he relayed. What you must come to realize is that through him, Rome
  evangelization took place, and the Gospel movement arose through Apostle Paul and the
  disciples.
- 4. You must deeply ponder and come to realize that God has done this all. There were many times that the works did not arise through the other Apostles, but only through Apostle Paul.
- 5. In Acts 16, an earthquake arose while Apostle Paul was in prison in the region of Philippi. In Acts 17, the city was in an uproar in Thessalonica. In Acts 19, Apostle Paul strongly spoke of the Gospel for two years in Tyrannus Hall, so all the Jews and Greeks of Asia heard the Gospel.
- 6. Also, those who touched Paul's handkerchief and apron were healed and all those who practiced magic arts brought their books and burned it. They counted the value of it and it came to fifty thousand pieces of silver. It was a lot of money for the laborers to earn back then, and they had to work for fifty thousand days, or about 137 years.
- 7. A ruckus arose through those who made idols in the region of Ephesus. All the people gathered and cried out to their gods for two hours but were left with confusion as to why they were doing that.
- 8. During that time, there were many disciples that saw miracles wherever they went. However, it was not to the extent of Apostle Paul to which it was not recorded in the Bible. There is a reason why God's work arose through Apostle Paul more than the other Apostles.
- 9. It was because Apostle Paul held to the accurate Gospel. He deeply realized Jesus Christ and accurately held to Jesus Christ. He deeply understood and had faith in Jesus Christ more compared to the rest.
- 10. As a result, the content determines everything. May it be the time that you confirm and have assurance of your Gospel. Another different trait that Apostle Paul had compared to the Apostles was the eyes for the disciples. Other Apostles had the system, but it was nothing compared to the answer that Apostle Paul received.
- 11. Apostle Paul never went to the fields by himself. He always went along with the disciples. It became a very important opportunity for team ministry evangelism. As he spent time with the disciples, many important messages that were based on the accurate Gospel were relayed to them.
- 12. As this continued, Apostle Paul raised many disciples' groups that saved the age. The representative group of that is the figures stated in Romans 16. Great evangelism arose during his time in prison in Rome.
- 13. He stayed in prison, and he relayed the messages to the disciples as they went to visit him. That was most of his ministry, but it was used as great representative evidence that fulfilled God's desire
- 14. May you deeply think about this as you desire to live the life of the disciple for the sake of world evangelization. May you think about this as you yearn to conquer your life and live the life masterpiece. For that to take place, you have faith, enjoy, and discover the accurate Gospel to the extent that your spiritual eyes are opened for evangelism. May this blessing be upon you.
- 15. For this all to be done, may you deeply confess that Jesus is your Christ and hold to Him as your covenant. May 24hrs be upon you to enjoy the bartizan, journey, and guidepost.
