# The Resurrection Message

1 Corinthians 15:1-11

You must worship God as you confirm and hold to the covenant. The answer is given and it is unchanging. The promising blood is God's sign to set you free from curses. The covenantal blood is the blood of life and there is life only in the blood. It contains the way for you to be revived. The Lord gave three promises in the covenantal blood. It is the promise of the complete and perfect King, Priest, and Prophet. By the precious blood of the cross, the covenant was completed. It is the complete answer to all problems that derive from original sin. It is a sufficient and complete answer. Those who believe in the answer are saved. Those who hold to the covenant as they pray will see the promising answer. Those who hold to the answer and pray will see all the promises fulfilled in their lives. Therefore, you must pray holding to the promising Word. If you continue this, miracles and recreation will arise and it will become a masterpiece. Once again, may you hold to the covenant as you give worship to God.

## 1. Resurrection

- 1) 1 Corinthians 15 is known as the resurrection of Christ. It records many messages regarding the resurrection. Apostle Paul had conviction of the Gospel he testified. 1 Corinthians 15:2 "And by which you are being saved if you hold fast to the word I preached to you - unless you believed in vain." Then, it records the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- 2) After Jesus was resurrected, he appeared to Cephas and last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to Paul. Apostle Paul testified that he was the least of the apostles, unworthy to be called an apostle because he persecuted the church of God, but it was all by God's grace he was called to be an Apostle.
- 3) For those who believe in the resurrection that is promised in the Gospel, it is their ultimate result and goal. 1 Corinthians 15:17 "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins."
- 4) 1 Corinthians 15:19 "If in Christ we hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied." Those who do not have the promise of resurrection will be at a loss and as a result, it will be a waste of time.
- 5) Therefore, the reason why you follow Jesus Christ is for eternal life and reward in heaven. Philippians 3:14 "I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." Philippians 3:13 "Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead." Apostle Paul had full conviction in this.
- 6) Apostle Paul's purpose and goal in life was for eternal life and the heavenly reward. He was a man that was centered on the eternal life in heaven. Those who are centered on the world will be defeated by Satan. The eternal life in heaven is all that matters, so you must live your life centered on it.
- 7) Your standard must be the eternal life and heavenly reward that is in the resurrection. May you be thankful that God has given you the resurrection of Jesus Christ to set you free from curses.

## 2. Message

- 1) The resurrection that is in Jesus Christ is God's ultimate goal and blessing. There are many of God's messages contained in the resurrection. Through the resurrection, the first message is to testify that Jesus is Christ. Next, it is to testify that Jesus Christ is the Son of God who bound the authority of death. Last but not least, it is to testify that all those who believe in Jesus Christ will resurrect in Him.
- 2) He came as the first fruit to be the evidence to all. Those who want to gain eternal life must come in Jesus Christ.
- 3) Not only is there life in Jesus Christ, but power and authority as well. The authority of life bound the authority of death and Satan. Not only that, it contains the power to save all. When you testify Jesus Christ, those who receive Christ will be saved. To save others, you must testify Jesus Christ to them.
- 4) Through Jesus Christ, your heart, thoughts, and life will be revived. Your economy, body, and fields will be revived. There is never a case that it will not. Those who apply the Word of Life to themselves will be revived.

- 5) You must first be revived to save others. That is why it is important to have the time to confess the covenant to yourself. Another message of God that is contained in the resurrection is to relay Jesus Christ to others.
- 6) Then, the grace of resurrection will be upon them. After Jesus was resurrected, he gave the last mission to the disciples. The disciples knew who the Lord was and received the absolute mission as their life.
- 7) It is important to receive God's mission. As much as God's kingdom is important, so is the mission. This is God's desire, so there is God's power and authority in the mission.
- 8) Through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, he has fundamentally crushed Satan's head, but those who receive the mission will crush the work of Satan. You must never lose hold of the mission until the work of Satan is destroyed. This is the power of the mission. It is not the mission that is done with your effort, but the mission that is given and fulfilled by God. The mission of God will never be defeated by Satan.
- 9) Regardless of what happens in the world, you must never lose hold of the mission. It is the absolute mission. Those who receive the mission will live this life. God will give you power.
- 10) For the sake of God's amazing kingdom to be established, the Lord gave four messages after he was resurrected. It is the covenant of 237, Healing, and Summit that you must hold to. The four messages are given by God and are the direction you must take. God proclaims that this is the work He will do to establish His kingdom in the end times. What will you do? He is asking, commanding, and requesting you to do this.
- 11) This is the believer's mission that they must partake in until Jesus Christ's Second Coming. This is the believer's life direction in this age. You must align your entire life with this.
- 12) Then, you will meet God and the Lord. This is where God will meet you. You must not be elsewhere or shout at the top of your lungs as you pray for it is all in vain.
- 13) You will face hardships and there will be no answers for you. This will ache God's heart if you don't hold to this as your direction. Therefore, you must carefully listen to the messages and hold to the Word. This is the reason why training is being emphasized.
- 14) There is one thing you must place in your heart. God will do according to what He has spoken. God tells you to "do it", but it means that God "will do it through you."
- 15) All you need to do is begin this. It's not a matter of doing it well or not but just begin it. All you have to do is begin the spiritual work. Through out the week, may you enjoy the mystery of the resurrection and the power and authority in the Life that has been given to you.
