My Son

Proverbs 3:1-10

1. My son

- 1) The Bible passage reaffirms an important covenant and records your promises to live by. May you once again receive God's word of promise, guided by the principle that God does everything according to His Word.
- 2) In Proverbs 3:1, God is calling his people. Proverbs 3:1 "My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments." God's laws are in the Bible, and God's sons must keep his commandments.
- 3) Proverbs 3:2-9 lists the teachings and commandments that should be kept before God and promises to bless you if you keep them. These are promises that God will bless you if you do not forget His laws and keep His commands in your heart.
- 4) But there are many teachings and commandments of God. The Bible is God's laws and principles. You must believe in Jesus and not worship idols. You must follow God's word. You must witness this Gospel to save people. You must love God with all your life. You must love your neighbor as yourself.
- 5) You should worship regularly, give offerings according to the seasons, set aside time to pray, teach your children the Gospel, serve the church, and give your life to evangelism and missions. There's probably a lot more because the Bible is God's law and command.
- 6) But those who enjoy Christ can keep all the commandments of God, and if you keep them with all your heart, God has promised to lengthen the days and years of your life and give you peace. He has promised that you find favor and good success in the sight of God and man. God will make your path straight for it will be healing to your flesh and refreshment to your bones. God will make your barns be filled with plenty and your vats will be bursting with wine.
- 7) For you shall not forget His teaching, but let your heart keep His commandments. It's a promise you want to fulfill and a blessing to receive. The condition is to keep God's teachings with all your heart and to write them on the tablet of your heart. This engraving is the secret to receiving this blessing. May you be blessed to be victorious as you deeply imprint this in your heart.

2. Christ is the mystery of God

- 1) Colossians 1:27 "Of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory." Jesus Christ is the mystery of God. Jesus Christ is the mystery to meet God. It is the mystery to bind curses and be set free; it is the mystery to crush Satan's head and conquer life and the world. Jesus Christ is the mystery to receive answers to prayer. It is a mystery to enjoy all of God's treasures. Jesus Christ is also the only mystery to know God and the world.
- 2) Jesus Christ is the mystery that knows why the sun still rises today, is the only mystery that knows why human beings become mentally ill. Jesus Christ is the only mystery that knows the curse and suffering of human beings. Jesus Christ is the answer to everything that happens in the world. This fact is also one of the mysteries of Christ.
- 3) Jesus Christ is the mystery to enjoy all the promises made in the Bible passage, but Christ is also the mystery to keep all of God's teachings and commandments. Enjoying Christ is the mystery for you to not forget God's law and teachings and have the spiritual strength to keep His commandments in your heart.
- 4) Jesus Christ gives you the power for His steadfast love and faithfulness to never forsake you. You must bind them around your neck and write them on the tablet of your heart. Jesus Christ is the mystery for you to trust in the Lord with all your heart and not to lean on your own understanding. If so, God will make your path straight. Jesus Christ is the mystery for you to not be wise in your own eyes, but fear the Lord and turn away from evil.
- 5) There is no other answer except for Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is the mystery to refresh your bones. He is the mystery for you to gain the spiritual power to honor your Lord with the firstfruits of all your

produce. He is the only mystery promised by God that will make your barns filled with plenty and your vats bursting with wine.

- 6) There is no way to do this except by Christ, and the Bible says it's very easy. Matthew 11:28-30 states, "My yoke is not like that of the Pharisees, for it is easy and light." You have nothing to do, for God will do it all. For Jesus will die, and you have no reason to die, but to enjoy His death. Therefore His covenant is easy and light.
- 7) The conclusion of all God's laws is Christ and His blood. He who knows Christ and the blood of His promise knows all the laws of God, and he who enjoys the blood of Christ has the power to fulfill them all. When you fail to keep God's laws, it is a spiritual problem. It is because Satan is in the way, and it is never for fleshly reasons.
- 8) How, then, can you keep God's teachings and laws and enjoy these promises for a lifetime of victory? The answer God has given you is to enjoy Jesus Christ. With the spiritual power that comes from enjoying Christ, it is possible to keep all of God's laws in the Bible perfectly. It is also possible to completely conquer the world and Satan.
- 9) And it is easy, for His yoke is easy and His burden is light. All you have to do is enjoy it. Do not strive to die for your own sake. You will be more harmed by Satan. Your efforts are not the answer. Strive, but do it in His covenant and for His covenant, and you will overcome and conquer everything.
- 10) God knows this principle and that's why He told all his people today to keep His teachings in their hearts and to write it on the tablet of their hearts. John 8:32 "And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." The truth is the Lord, and the Lord is the law of God; therefore, to keep Christ in your heart is to keep the law of God. May you be blessed to think deeply of Christ once again and be victorious.
