

A Time for Every Matter

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8

1. A time for every matter

- 1) Ecclesiastes 3:1 "For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven." It's God's timing, so it's an absolute time schedule that no one can touch. It's an absolute principle that it's best to just go along with it, and if you can't, you have to obey it, and it doesn't matter how hard you try not to go along with it.
- 2) The Creation order is a principle to which all creation must obey unconditionally; in fact, it is within this order that they sustain their lives. Even those who blaspheme against God are sustained by the grace of the Creator's order.
- 3) The one who knows and follows is the one whose eyes are open, and God's absolute sovereignty will become a covenant and a gratitude. because God's absolute, unchanging principles will become a blessing to you, a blessing that you can go to for better, peace, ease, and trust.
- 4) There's a time for every matter, so don't worry, follow God, and He will guide and bless your life. You just need to follow His principle.
- 5) No matter how much you try to deviate from this principle and live your own, you can never do it. Mankind can't even sustain life without what God has given them. You need to open our spiritual eyes, be grateful, obey God's will, and if we must, obey it. This principle is fundamental to sustaining life and enjoying God's promises.
- 6) One more thing to add to this is the spiritual battle against Satan, who stands in the way of blessings. This evil one is the cause of original sin and is the cause of all your problems now. Once you begin the spiritual battle, God will surely work as promised. So the message is, God will give you His time.
- 7) That's why God says there is a time for every matter. You must wait for that time. God is the Lord and Master of that time, and that time is best for you. God wants to bless you, never curse you. You will never see God curse you.
- 8) The secret to enjoying this blessing even now is to continue the spiritual battle of crushing Satan's head with the covenant. Keep it in mind, don't forget it, keep it up even when you don't want to, and God will show you His timing.
- 9) The Bible concludes that one covenant solves all problems. There is one cause and one answer. That one cause caused countless problems, and the one covenant solves all problems and makes you a witness of the Lord to the ends of the earth. May this wonderful blessing be upon you.

2. Absolute sovereignty

- 1) Ecclesiastes 3:14 "I perceived that whatever God does endures forever; nothing can be added to it, nor anything taken from it. God has done it, so that people fear before him." Ecclesiastes 3:11 "He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, he has put eternity into man's heart, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end."
- 2) It refers to God's absolute authority. It means that no one can go outside this limit, and everything must be within this principle, and if you don't want to obey, you must submit. If someone doesn't want to submit, it doesn't matter if they spend their whole life yelling, cursing, and scolding God. It doesn't matter what they do. It's better to let go of themselves and follow. This is the fate of all creations. Those who acknowledge are blessed because they will enjoy and live.
- 3) So God is the absolute in all creations. He is the total conqueror, the total absolute, who can do anything, and nothing can be done without God's permission. Because He is omnipotent, He can do everything, and everything must be done through Him for it to work. Not a single thing or a single moment will be an exception. It's perfection itself.
- 4) You are freed from Satan's destiny by the blood of Christ, but the principle of God's absolute sovereignty remains alive in you. It is alive as fate. It is God's destiny. Of course, it's a thankful and blessed destiny; the more destined you are, the better.
- 5) So God even turns your sins or mistakes into His glory. Joseph may have made a mistake in telling his brothers about his dream. If he hadn't told them, the dream would still have been fulfilled. But because

he told them, he was sold into slavery. Now, maybe he was a little bit prideful at the time, maybe he looked down on his brothers a little bit, and that's not something that could be a mistake. However, Joseph's problem became the beginning of something that saved his era. There are many examples like this in the Bible.

- 6) If you are struggling with guilt of one sort or another, you need to think a little differently: it's bad enough to sin, but it's not God's will for you to be weighed down by it again; a good conscience is precious, but it can't outweigh the Lord's death; you can't justify sinning, but you can't justify being weighed down by it either; you don't need to be. Sin is between you and God, not Satan's business.
- 7) God has already forgiven and promised to see your sin no more. May you be free from them today. May there be a spiritual battle today to crush the serpent's head with the blood of the promise. It was Jesus' forgiveness that saved the woman caught in the act of adultery, so you just need to repent to God, forgive yourself first, and continue the work of breaking Satan's head with the blood of the covenant.
- 8) This Absolute Being tells you to preach His gospel. He tells you to enjoy and triumph, to crush Satan's head, and to save many. God is always preparing a time schedule of blessings for you. There is a season for everything. May you be one of those who wait to enjoy and triumph in the covenant. Become an evangelist, and you will be blessed to enjoy all the promises in the Bible.
